Mosquito Control

Homeowner Mosquito Abatement Checklist

The following checklist will aid in reducing mosquito breeding sites on your property. Perform these tasks at least weekly for best results (Please keep for future reference):

- Dispose of or cover scrap tires
- Check tree-holes for water. If water is found, fill the hole or treat the water
- Empty any children's toys that can hold water
- Keep ditches clear of weeds, trash, and lawn clippings
- Saving rainwater for plants? Cover container with window screen
- Empty and change water in birdbaths and plant trays regularly
- Throw out any tin cans, bottles, or other debris that can hold water
- Change outdoor pet's water bowls daily
- Empty tarps that hold water (swimming pool tarps, boat tarps, etc.)
- Clean out gutters and keep them free of debris
- Empty wading pools/ children's plastic swimming pools daily
- Drain temporary pools of water or fill in with dirt
- Empty/ discard any other items on your property that can hold water
